The ACP Internal Medicine In-Training Examination® is a web-based self-assessment exam designed for residency programs to assess the progress of their residents during training and in preparation for the initial certification exam.

The IM-ITE® is developed by a committee of expert physicians and is used by residency programs to assess , during training and in preparation for their initial certification exam. It is modeled after the American Board of Internal Medicine's certification exam. The exam is administered annually during a strictly monitored window.

Give residents an opportunity for self-assessment. Give program directors the opportunity to evaluate their programs. Identify areas in which residents need extra assistance.
